 - To be decided by the PRACE AISBL Council



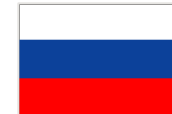
Some numbers

 - New industrial domains (renewable energies, electromagnetism)



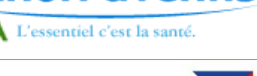
Some numbers
